Membership in the Guild lasts a lifetime, providing your work continually meets Guild quality standards and annual dues are maintained. Kits, imports, or mass produced items will not be accepted.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

BRAG membership is open to artisans who reside in the following northwest North Carolina counties: Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Caldwell, Iredell, Surry, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yadkin.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- **Written** - Applicants must submit a completed application including their personal information, media designation, and \$25.00 non-refundable submission fee.
- **Images** – Application requires (5) color images of each media type submitted, including retail price and description of each image. Digital images are preferred and can be emailed or submitted on a CD-ROM or USB Flash Drive. director@blueridgeartisancenter.org
- Applications are reviewed by the Standards Committee and if accepted will be invited back for the Object Submission Phase of the Jury.
- **Object Jury Process** – Applicants who are invited back will need to bring (5) physical pieces of their work for the Standards Committees review. (Please note: A set, such as a companion set for hearth cooking consisting of a poker, rake, shovel, and stand would be considered as one object.)
- **Media Designation:** A maximum of two media designations per application only. Each media requires 5 images as well as 5 separate objects per media.

Please check-in at the front door of the Blue Ridge Artisan Center. Artists with large objects may be directed to the loading dock upon check-in.

Please note: This is an anonymous jury. Therefore, do not put your name on the images, other attachments, or physical objects for jury review.

If you would like for your images to be returned, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope with enough postage to accommodate their return. Images of accepted applicants will be retained by the Guild office for its membership files and for marketing purposes to promote the Guild and its membership.

JURY PROCESS

- The Jury consists of 5 to 7 voting members of the Standards Committee.
- The Standards Committee will review the written application, description and images to determine which applicants will be invited back for the Object Submission Phase of the Jury.
- Once reviewed those accepted will be invited to bring their Objects to be examined for suitability of membership.
- If the applicant is accepted for BRAG membership, the Annual Membership Dues are \$50 (of which original \$25 application Fee will be deducted.)
- If the applicant is not accepted and re-applies within one year of the date of initial application, the re-application Fee will be waived.
- Notification will be made by postal mail within 14 days of the jurying process.

EVALUATING THE APPLICANT'S WORK

- The Standards Committee is searching for members whose works show excellence in concept, design and technique. The Standards Committee's Evaluation is based on a combination of the following criteria:
- Handmade Items using hand tools or hand directed machine tools such as a potter's wheel or wood turning lathe. *We are focused on discovering original, handmade works, the purposefulness of hand tool marks and texture will be examined.*
- Individual Expression (Original or Traditional)
- Innovative Design or Technique
- High Quality Consistent Craftsmanship
- Exemplary Composition
- Durability
- Functionality of the piece, such as a chair designed to sit in without collapsing or such as an item designed for aesthetic viewing only.
- Exhibition Potential
- Product Marketability
- Professional Presentation
